

JIM MILLER OF "WILLOW WINDS" FEATURED AT THE GLADWIN COUNTY CARRIAGE FESTIVAL

Jim Miller will be a feature of the Cedar River Ranch - Childrens' zone of the Gladwin Carriage Festival on Saturday & Sunday, August 11 & 12, 2012 from noon to 6 pm on Saturday and noon to closing on Sunday.

Outdoorsman and writer, Jim Miller is one of the nation's leading advocates of the study and application of traditional skills and crafts. The Port Huron, Michigan native discovered the beauty and essence of the natu-

ral world at an early age and has spent countless hours studying the skills of our ancestors in woods, fields and streams throughout the Great Lakes region.

After sharing the joys and knowledge of outdoor skills and crafts with family and friends, Jim Miller found growing numbers of people eager to learn from his experiences. Over the past several years he has become a highly sought after lecturer and instructor. His "how-to" demonstrations are featured regularly at special events around the country.

Traditional skills presented include: birch bark canoes and handcarved paddles, birchbark baskets, buffalo hides, hand-woven natural fiber bags, cordage (string) made of plant fibers and tree bark, bone and stone tools, arrowheads, wooden bows, drums of buffalo rawhide, pine pitch glue, cups and bowls fashioned from clay using only fire as a kiln, fire with the bow drill and hand spindle (rubbing sticks together) and many other techniques for living in harmony with the earth. All of these are unique processes that awaken our awareness of the natural world in which we live.

Be sure to look him up at our Annual Carriage Festival, August 11 & 12th.





New Carriage Debuts at Fourth of July Parade

A new visitor came to this spring's Memorial Day Parade in Gladwin – the "Kerswill Carriage." The newly acquired carriage was drawn by ":Whisper," a mare owned and driven by Pam Millhisler.

The carriage came to the Gladwin County Historical Society through the generosity of the Gladwin Rotary Club, the City of Gladwin, the Gladwin Business and Professional Association, and others. Kenneth Kerswill was a life member of both the Gladwin Rotary Club and the Gladwin County Historical Society, and items from his estate are on display at the Gladwin County Historical Museum. The carriage is named in his honor.

The carriage is a replica of a Victorian

runabout, built by the Robert Jones and Sons Company of Ontario, Canada. It was purchased from its former and original owner and is now housed here in Gladwin.

It will be featured in the Gladwin County Fair Opening Day Parade and in Beaverton's Fourth of July Parade. It will also participate in this year's Gladwin County Carriage Festival August 10, 11, and 12, and it just might be seen around the area during other events.







Michigan Equine Activity Statute

MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS ANNOTATED CHAPTER 691. JUDICIARY EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT

691.1666. Warning signs and notices

Sec. 6. (1) An equine professional shall post and maintain signs that contain the warning notice set forth in subsection (3). The signs shall be placed in a clearly visible location in close proximity to the equine activity. The warning notice shall appear on the sign in conspicuous letters no less than 1 inch in height.

(2) A written contract entered into by an equine professional for providing professional services, instruction, or rental of equipment, tack, or an equine to a participant, whether or not the contract involves an equine activity on or off the location or site of the equine professional's business, shall contain in clearly readable print the warning notice set forth in subsection (3).

(3) A sign or contract described in this section shall contain substantially the following warning notice:

WARNING

Under the Michigan equine activity liability act, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in an equine activity resulting from an inherent risk of the equine activity.




