

- Print clearly and place only one recipe per form.
- If more room is needed, attach another sheet of paper.
- List all ingredients in order of use in ingredients list.
- Include container sizes, e.g., 16-oz. pkg., 24-oz. can.
- Keep directions in paragraph form, not in steps.
- Use names of ingredients in the directions, e.g., “Combine flour and sugar.”
- Include temperatures and times for cooking, chilling, etc.
- Include a one or two sentences history in regard to the recipe, if you wish.
